BARNSTABLE, CAPE COD TO BARNSTAPLE, ENGLAND –OUTLINE ITINERARY

FRI, SEP 5- UNITED STATES TO LONDON

Depart Cape Cod and take an overnight flight across the Atlantic.

SAT, SEP 6- STONEHENGE & BATH

After landing at Heathrow Airport, complete customs and immigration formalities. Then your CIE Tours driver and guide will welcome you to England and escort you and your luggage to the coach. Enjoy breakfast on your way out of the London metropolitan area. Drive west to visit one of Britain's most celebrated monuments - Stonehenge. Set on Salisbury Plain, it is comprised of the remains of a double circle of monoliths, which dates from approximately 3000 BC. It is believed to have been used by the ancient Druids for sun worship or as a burial ground. The amazing feat of engineering where primitive people transported stone slabs from South Wales perhaps and set them upright with such precision has inspired much research and conjecture. Continue to Bath, a spa town which has been well known for its natural hot springs for almost 2,000 years since the Roman era. Check into your hotel and enjoy the balance of the afternoon at leisure for independent activities. In the evening join your fellow travelers for dinner in the hotel restaurant.

BAILBROOK HOUSE, BATH (B, D)

SUN, SEP 7- ROMAN BATHS, CASTLE COMBE & BRISTOL

This morning visit the Roman Baths. From here travel to the picturesque Cotswold village of Castle Combe, sometimes referred to as the "Prettiest Village in England". Enjoy some free time to view the charming buildings built of local honey colored stone and enhanced with delightful gardens. After your visit, board your coach and head for the city of Bristol. Bristol is a historical port rich in seafaring traditions and shares many links with the early colonization of America. Return to your hotel and in the evening stop at the Guildhall for independently arranged activities.

BAILBROOK HOUSE, BATH (B)

MON, SEP 8- WELLS, GLASTONBURY & BARNSTAPLE

Depart Bath and drive south to the town of Wells named after St. Andrew's Well, the sacred spring that bubbles up from the ground near the Bishop's Palace. Enjoy some time to explore the town before boarding your coach for Glastonbury where you will visit the majestic ruins of Glastonbury Abbey. The Abbey's history dates back to the 7th century, when the base of the Abbey was said to have been made. From here travel to the town of Barnstaple in North Devon and check into your hotel. Spend the balance of the day at leisure for individual sightseeing, shopping and more. Tonight, join group for dinner at the hotel restaurant.

SAUNTON SANDS HOTEL, BARNSTAPLE (B, D)

TUE, SEP 9- DOONE VALLEY & DUNSTER CASTLE

After breakfast, set out for a full day's tour of North Devon. Visit the Doone Valley, made famous by R.D. Blackmore's Lorna Doone. This isolated valley is great for country walks and is a popular place to camp in Britain. Then travel to Dunster Castle to visit this ancient castle turned country home. The site has been occupied for over 1,000 years. The castle boasts spectacular views toward the Bristol Channel, the Quantock Hills and up to the moors of Exmoor. Return to Barnstaple where the balance of the day is for individual pursuits and dining.

SAUNTON SANDS HOTEL, BARNSTAPLE (B)

WED, SEP 10- TINTAGEL CASTLE & BODMIN MOOR

Leaving Barnstaple, journey south and into Cornwall to visit Tintagel Castle. This magical location is set high on the rugged North Cornwall coast and is reputed to be the birthplace of the legendary, King Arthur. Explore the ruined castle where it is said that King Uther Pendragon met with the beautiful Igraine and conceived King Arthur. You can also visit Merlin's Cave and climb the rugged trail across to the island to enjoy the stunning sea views - on a good day you can see as far as Lundy Island, off the North Devon coast. Then travel to Bodmin Moor, an unspoiled granite moorland filled with prehistoric and medieval history. From Bodmin Moor, travel to Plymouth and check into your hotel and enjoy some free time to explore the city before meeting group for dinner.

NEW CONTINENTAL, PLYMOUTH (B, D)

THU, SEP 11- DARTMOOR NATIONAL PARK, PENZANCE, TRURO & LAND'S END

After breakfast, visit Dartmoor National Park, in south Devon. The park is famous for its granite hilltops which provide habitats for Dartmoor's extensive wildlife such as ponies, rabbits, foxes, badgers and weasels just to name a few. Continue your drive southwest to Penzance, a famous Cornish port town and perhaps encounter a pirate or two before visiting Truro, once a bustling river port during the late 18th and early 19th centuries, today it is famous for its elegant townhouses that line the streets. Enjoy some time to browse around through the maze of shops and restaurants. From here, journey to Land's End, England's most westerly point. Enjoy dramatic views and windswept moors as you travel back to Plymouth, where the remainder of the day is at leisure.

NEW CONTINENTAL, PLYMOUTH (B)

FRI, SEP 12- HAMPTON COURT PALACE

Departing Plymouth, drive north through Exeter to Hampton Court Palace. Hampton Court Palace is set in handsome gardens and parkland close to the River Thames. Tour the Palace to see the collections of pictures, furniture and tapestries. Special attractions include the Tudor Kitchens, the great gatehouse, the Hampton Court Vine - and the maze, laid out in the time of William III. After your tour, travel to London and check into your hotel. The afternoon and evening are at leisure to explore the great pubs and restaurants that London has to offer.

COPTHORNE TARA HOTEL, LONDON (B)

SAT, SEP 13- S LONDON CITY TOUR

This morning an orientation tour of the city center will introduce you to some of London's famous landmarks. See the Houses of Parliament with Big Ben and nearby Westminster Abbey. Drive through Trafalgar Square where the National Gallery and St. Martin-in-the-Fields Church are located before driving to St. Paul's Cathedral for a visit. The balance of the afternoon is at leisure. In the evening, join group at a local historic pub for dinner.
