## **Pension Update Solvency Status:**

No doubt many of you were surprised, hopefully pleasantly, when, on January 22, 2014, the Company announced that as a result of:

- the benefits derived from the arbitrations' awards of last year,
- the normalization of the company's required payments which allowed a reduced contribution of \$225M
- a return on investment of 13.8% during 2013 and
- the use of a 3.9% discount rate to calculate the Pension Plan actuarial liability as of Jan 1, 2014 (up from the 3% used Jan 1, 2013); **the Canadian Pension Plan Solvency Status at January 1, 2014 would be in a small surplus.**

In 2009, following the financial downturn of 2008, both Air Canada and the Pension Trust Fund faced great challenges. As a result of the Company's initiatives, the Union's cooperation and the Pionairs' support, an acceptable solution was developed which included the Government. The Government issued the Air Canada special Regulations 2009 which permitted the Company to temporarily suspend and reduce its pension solvency payments for 5 years. These regulations terminated December 2013 and were replaced, following concerted negotiations with all parties (Unions, Pionairs, Government and Air Canada) by promulgation of the Air Canada Pension Plan funding Regulations 2014. These Regulations remain in place until December 2020 and essentially continued the financial relief to the Company. The intent of these Regulations was to relieve the Company over a period of time of payments of excessive amounts mainly due to world economic conditions. The Pionairs, as you know, were fully supportive of these Company initiatives based on the belief that the financial success of the Company would be beneficial to the retirees. At this date, the strategy has resulted in a stronger Air Canada and an on-going Pension Trust fund whose solvency liability, at this time, has been eliminated.

Concurrently, the Company has revised the Pension Plan Strategies so as to minimize the possibility of future volatility due to world economic conditions. We need to recognize these initiatives and continue to assist Air Canada in its future endeavors.

May I also apologize for the lengthy absence of communications from the Pension Committee over the last several months. A number of issues have arisen, which required the Committee's focus:

The development of the **Air Canada Pension Plan Funding Regulations** by the Government and the Pionairs' participation by commenting on those regulations during their development.

2. The concluding elements in the **CCA/BIA hearings** before the Superior Court of Quebec and the ultimate negative outcome for AVEOS employees and retirees.
3. **Research and Study of the details of the CCA/BIA** which allow the Courts to negate the requirements of the PBSA, whose requirements the Pionairs, along with other retiree organizations, brought about in the 2010 budget.

Because each of the above issues constitutes a topic unto itself, over the next several weeks we will attempt to broaden the details of each issue. In the meantime, on behalf of the Pension & Benefits Committee, I wish each and every Pionairs Member a Healthy, Happy and Successful New Year.

### **GENERIC DRUG REIMBURSEMENT – Effective February 1, 2014**

#### ***To all Active and Retired Employees in Canada***

Air Canada is committed to offering our employees high quality health care coverage. However, to ensure the longevity of our group health plans, we must adopt efficient practices that reduce waste. Accordingly, effective February 1, we will favor the reimbursement of generic drugs whenever this alternative is available.

Health professionals agree that brand name drugs and their generic counterparts are interchangeable. Both contain the same active ingredients and dosage options, and must meet the same government regulations for quality, effectiveness, potency, purity and safety. However, generic drugs, which treat the same symptoms as their brand-name equivalent, are significantly less costly.

Therefore, prescriptions dispensed on or after February 1, will be reimbursed as follows:

- If the drug is available in a generic format, the cost of the generic drug is what will be reimbursed.
- If the drug is only available in a brand name format, the brand name cost will be reimbursed.


**Please note:** Employees and retirees whose prescriptions date from before February 1, 2014 and who have submitted claims in the past six months for brand name drugs with a generic alternative, will be reimbursed the cost of the brand name drug.

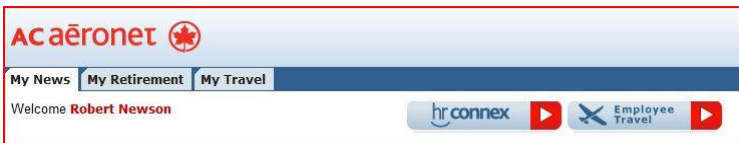

**Keep your employee profile up-to-date.** Your employee profile contains personal information that allows Air Canada to interact with you on various matters. Please be sure to keep it updated so that it reflects your current address, phone numbers, emergency contacts, and any other personal details that may have changed.

To do so, log into HR Connex and click under "Personal Information." You will have the option to make changes.

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**Reminder: FedEx employee discount ended.** As a result of recent discussions between FedEx and Air Canada, changes were made to our corporate agreement. In order to mutually benefit both organizations, the agreement was re-crafted to better align with business requirements and corporate priorities. As a result, and effective January 1, 2014, FedEx no longer offers Air Canada employees and retirees the previous discount. Discussions are ongoing and should alternative benefits be extended in the future, the revised benefits will be communicated accordingly.

**Reminder: Air Canada Cargo offers active and retired Air Canada mainline, Air Canada Express and Air Canada rouge employees discounts for shipment of personal goods.** Upon presentation of their Air Canada ID, eligible employees may receive a discount on the shipment of personal goods to/from Air Canada stations that offer Cargo services.

Please note:

- Cargo shipments are airport to airport. Goods must be dropped off and retrieved at an Air Canada Cargo station (although some stations do offer delivery to the final destination).
- Shipping to the US is unavailable due to mandated security measures.
- Security screening fees will apply.
- Export/import restrictions may apply.
