

MIT professor **Nancy Kanwisher** uses fMRI to discover brain regions that conduct very specific mental functions, including the visual perception of faces, places, and bodies, as well as aspects of social cognition and language. Kanwisher received a MacArthur Fellowship in Peace and International Security, a Troland Research Award, a MacVicar Faculty Fellow Teaching Award, and a Golden Brain Award. She is a member of the National Academy of Sciences and the American Academy of Arts and Sciences.
