

Capes	6 to 24	Widest array of hook sizes and colors - best known dry fly hackle	dry flies
Saddles	two sizes	Narrow range of hook sizes, longer, uniform feather - good for dry fly hackling	dry flies
Midge Saddles	18 & smaller	80% are for size 18 and smaller with a few larger.	dry flies

Capes	6 to 20	Partially webby for collars, good for legs, dry fly wings and streamer collars	nymphs & wet flies
Saddles	12 to 16	Completely webby - good for collars and legs on nymphs	bluegill, wet flies & nymphs
High & Dry Capes	10 to 18	Core colors for the fly tier, in a wide range of sizes	dry flies
Whiting Bugger Packs	10 & larger	Genetic hackle specially bred for woolly buggers, a mainstay for fly tying	woolly buggers, streamers & bass flies
Hebert/Miner Rooster			
Capes	8 to 20	High quality but less expensive with exceptional natural colors	dry flies
Saddles	10 to 14	Longer feathers with excellent colors	dry flies
Hebert/Miner Hen			
Capes	16 to 10	Soft, webby feather with a slight taper - perfect for collars or small streamer wings	wet flies, streamers & nymphs
Saddles	12 & larger	Very webby feather with rounded tip - good for collars, legs & small streamer wings	large wet flies, streamers & nymphs

Saddle	10 to 16	Long, slightly tapered feathers in an array of colors	larger dry flies and streamer flies

Capes	12 & larger	Softer, semi dry feathers in natural and cream badger, or cream badger dyed	lake flies, Irish flies & streamers
Saddles	10 & larger	Excellent for dry fly tailing - some heavily speckled (Pardo)	large dry flies

Capes	10 to 18	Soft wispy feather - each is a unique mottled brown	wet flies & nymphs

Coq de Leon Tailing Pack	8 to 26	Long, glossy natural tailing fibers, some with speckling ("pardo")	dry flies

Capes	12 & larger	Large, full streamer feathers - excellent for collars or dry fly tails	streamers, saltwater, & wet flies
Saddles	12 & larger	Feathers are webby and tapered - large assortment of colors and sizes	streamers, saltwater, steelhead & salmon flies
American Hen Hackle			
Capes	10 to 14	Perfect for tails and collars in a wide array of colors	tarpon, pike, musky, bass & wet flies
Saddles	6 to 12	Velvety smooth, wide and webby in natural and brilliantly dyed colors	saltwater, steelhead, salmon, bass & wet flies
Streamer/Deceiver Packs	10 & larger	Sturdy, more rigid feathers - less likely to foul the hook. Natural and dyed	bass, tarpon, pike & musky flies
Schlappen & Tail Feathers	10 & larger	Long, tapered, webby feathers, in a wide variety of grizzly and white dyed colors	woolly buggers, billfish, striped bass & salmon flies
Spey Rooster Hackle			
Capes	10 & larger	Largest sizes and longest barb length, wide choice of colors	spey, saltwater & bass flies
Saddles	10 & larger	Long wispy feathers that are great for spey leech and tailing for saltwater flies	spey, saltwater & bass flies
Super 'Bou	10 & larger	Marabou substitute with fluffy, medium length feathers - less coarse than turkey	woolly buggers, leech & nymphs

Capes	6 to 20	Soft, perfect for collars - cream badger and some tinted colors	small wet flies & nymphs
Hen Soft Hackle Chick-A-Bou	6 to 20	CDC substitute, small marabou and soft hackle in natural and many dyed colors	emergers, nymphs & wet flies
Saddle	10 to 16	Mottled grey is great partridge substitute - tinted colors also available	small wet flies & nymphs
Bird Fur	10 & larger	Heron substitute - long, thin hair-like fibers on a flexible stem	spey, dee-style flies, shrimp & saltwater flies
