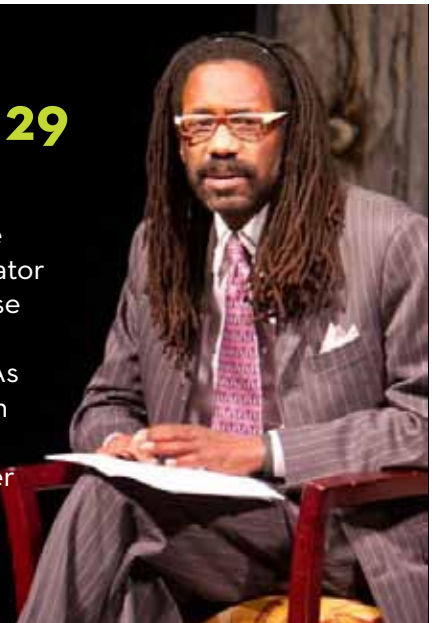

Michael Coard, a criminal defense attorney in Philadelphia with 20 years of state and federal trial experience, specializes in murder cases and formerly worked at the Charles W. Bowser Law Center after having served as Legal Counsel for State Senator Hardy Williams. Currently, he is a member of the Occupy Philadelphia Legal Defense Team. He is a recipient of the Philadelphia Bar Association's prestigious Thurgood Marshall Award and the Philadelphia NAACP's prestigious Cecil B. Moore Award. As a community activist, he is a founding member of Avenging The Ancestors Coalition (ATAC). He is General Counsel and Executive Vice President of the Philadelphia Millions More Movement, a former state board member of the ACLU, and a member of the Pennsylvania Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers. In addition, he writes a weekly column for *Philadelphia Magazine's* Philly Post and hosts the popular Afrocentric "Radio Courtroom" show on WURD-900AM.
