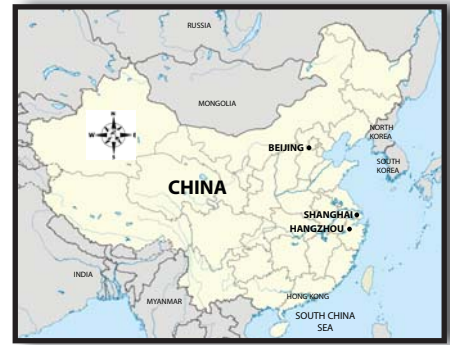

ITINERARY

Day 1: Arrive Los Angeles (LAX)

This evening arrive Los Angeles Airport (LAX) for your pre-flight check-in.

Day 2: Depart USA / Los Angeles (LAX)

Board your early morning flight bound for **Beijing, China**. En route cross the International Dateline. During this Chamber of Commerce tour, you will see the incredible highlights of China with opportunities to experience the local culture and learn about business development in China.

Day 3: Arrive Beijing (L,D)

Arrive this morning in **Beijing**, home of 2008 Summer Olympics! Beijing is a fascinating capital with a treasure of beautifully preserved palaces, tombs and relics. Today enjoy a visit to the **Temple of Heaven** where the emperors prayed for the good harvest. Here you will see hundreds of Chinese practicing their morning exercises. Later see Olympic Games sights and the famous **Olympics Bird's Nest & Water Bubbles buildings**. Enjoy a Chinese lunch and check in to your hotel for a three night stay. The afternoon is at leisure. Day 4: Beijing Sightseeing (B,L)

Meet your local representative and tour the **Summer Palace**, the ancient royal palace built by the Dragon lady in the last dynasty. After an included lunch, visit **Tiananmen Square**, the symbolic heart of China and gathering place for the masses. Today an **International Business Exchange** will be available to learn about local business practices.

Day 5: Great Wall (B,L,D)

Today enjoy a full day visit to one of the greatest man-made wonders of the world, the **Great Wall of China**. You'll likely never forget your first sight of the Great Wall: one of mankind's most remarkable feats, this impenetrable barrier stretches 4,000 miles. Visit the Sacred Way of the Ming Tomb where you will see the many ancient stone carved animals. Tonight enjoy a special **Peking Duck Dinner**.

Overnight: Beijing

Day 6: Beijing - Hangzhou (B,L)

This morning transfer to the airport for your flight to **Shanghai**. Upon arrival in Shanghai, meet a local representative and transfer to **Hangzhou**, which is well-known for its beautiful natural scenery. It is also the capital city of Zhejiang Province, one of the most wealthy regions in China. After lunch at a local restaurant, enjoy a **West Lake Boat Cruise** for some of the most beautiful scenery in China. Many ancient poets write their poems based on West Lake. After dinner, an optional traditional Foot Massage will be available.

Overnight: Hangzhou

Day 7: Hangzhou - Shanghai (B,L)

This morning visit the Economic Development Zone with a briefing on investment opportunity. Later visit **Lingyin Temple**, one of the ten most famous Buddhist temples in China and considered a leading center for research relative to Chinese Buddhist culture. Later visit the famous tea plantation of the "Dragon Well" tea which is only grown in the Hangzhou area. This afternoon transfer to Shanghai, the most cosmopolitan city in China. Upon arrival in Shanghai, check into your hotel and enjoy dinner with your fellow travelers.

Overnight: Shanghai

Day 8: Shanghai (B,L,D)

Today enjoy a **Shanghai City Tour** of this great city where East meets West. Shanghai is China's largest city with 14 million people, and is a paradise for adventure and excitement. Ride along the **Bund**, the riverside boulevard that is Shanghai's showpiece and view the 1930's era high-rise architecture. Then visit the **Garden of the Mandarin Yu** & a **Silk Weaving Workshop**. This evening an Optional Acrobatic Show will be offered after dinner.

Day 9: Shanghai (Xian & the Terracotta Warriors optional tour) (B)

Enjoy a full day at leisure to explore Shanghai on your own or join a full day optional tour to **Xian** to see the incredible **Terracotta Warriors**, sure to be a major highlight of your tour to China. This evening enjoy a dinner on your own.

China Visa REQUIREMENTS: A visa is required for entrance into China. Visa cost is additional and approximately **\$195 per person**. Please log on to **Generations Visa Service** at www.genvisa.com to obtain a China Visa Form and for additional information. The cost of your China Visa includes service fees, consular fees and return shipping to you.

PASSPORT INFORMATION: A valid passport is required for this tour and is the responsibility of each passenger. Passports should be valid for up to six (6) months beyond the travel dates. All names must be submitted to Chamber Explorations exactly as they appear on passenger passports.

*AIRLINE FUEL SURCHARGES / FEES: Are presently \$310 and are **INCLUDED** in the tour rates. (subject to increase / change)

*AIR DEPARTURE TAXES: Are presently \$100 per person and are **INCLUDED** in the tour rates, are subject to increase / change and due with final payment.
