WORKING FOR YOU Chamber working to improve sign ordinance

he Amelia Island-Fernandina Beach-Yulee Chamber of Commerce is working closely with Nassau County Growth Management to improve current sign regulations within the SR 200/Florida A1A overlay district.

The Chamber facilitated a meeting between stakeholders along the corridor and county planning staff to provide input on proposed changes. The Chamber's Board of Directors followed up with a letter to the county Planning & Zoning Board advocating for two key improvements to the draft ordinance.

The first was to allow businesses to display banner advertising within a standalone anchor featuring architectural foam columns with a cap and concrete foundation as opposed to the proposed monument-sign anchors which -- at costs ranging from \$4,000 to \$10,000 -- are prohibitively expensive for most businesses.

While a business would need a construction permit to install the anchor, no permits would be needed for the banners displayed within the anchor. Banners may be changed as often as a business sees fit.

The Chamber also recommended that existing electronic signs be allowed to display three different messages within a 24-hour period (excluding time, temperature and emergency messages). The current ordinance only allows one message a day.

CHAMBER SUPPORTS SECOND FERRY CONCESSION

he Board of Directors in May wrote the National Park Service in support of adding a concession for ferry service from Fernandina Beach to Cumberland Island National Seashore in Georgia.

Passengers would be able transfer to the St. Marys, Ga.-based ferry to continue onto the Georgia mainland if they want, under the Chamber proposal.

The Board believes a second, Fernandina Beach-based ferry would not only benefit Nassau County businesses but also facilitate access to Cumberland Island.
