On Saturday and Sunday, October 18 & 19, The Original Farmers Market will host our oldest and most popular annual event, Fall Festival. The free harvest celebration features something for everyone – children's activities, lots of music, pie-eating contests and crafts demonstrations. There's even a Fall Festival Kick-Off Concert on the West Patio on Friday evening, the 17th.

You're sure to enjoy Artisan Alley on Gilmore Lane, featuring pumpkin and leather carving, a harvest knot craft workshop, wool spinning, a blacksmith demonstrating live horseshoeing, basket weaving and flintknapping (the art of making arrowheads). Artisan Alley will also have lots of local fresh produce for sale.

Be sure to visit The Great American Petting Zoo, an animal friendly meet-and-greet with llamas, goats and more. Right next door a midway

for youngsters, Agventure Play Land, will offer fun farm-based activities.



Fall Festival stages on the Market Plaza and the East and West Patios will feature great banjo, country,

bluegrass and rockabilly music. There's special entertainment just for kids, too – the Bob Baker Marionettes and Sheriff Pickett's Stories of the West. The Plaza stage will also offer the sloppiest competitions ever, No Hands pie-eating contests.
