What type of player is Jersey Intensity looking for?

What are the benefits of playing on a club team?

The Jersey Intensity field hockey staff is made up of successful former college players and National Team members. We have all been through the recruiting process, both as players and as Division I college coaches, and are here to help as you and your family go through this process.
