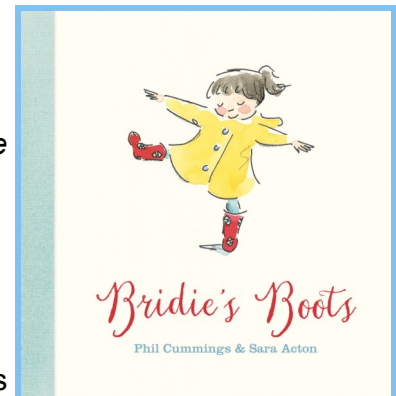

Phil Cummings has written over 60 books for children, including *Anzac Biscuits*, *Boom Bah!*, *Night Watch*, *Danny Allen Was Here*, and *Take it Easy Danny Allen*. He's an ambassador for the Premier's Reading Challenge in SA, the Dad's Read Campaign for the State Library, and was an ambassador for the National Year of Reading in 2012. Phil has received a number of honours and awards in Australia and overseas including *Anzac Biscuits* being named a CBCA Notable Book and *Night Watch* being shortlisted for the Australian Speech Pathology Children's Book Awards. *Anzac Biscuits*, *Boom Bah!* and *Night Watch* were also recently presented to the Duke and Duchess of Cambridge as a gift to their son Prince George to commemorate his visit to Australia.
