## Materials and Techniques Cheat Sheet

About: I realize that only accepting textile based submissions, and paper submissions (only if laminated) can be limiting to groups and schools. Thus a cheat sheet has been created in hopes to help you get a better idea of different materials and techniques that others have used. You will also notice how these different submissions found ways to meet our 2 foot x 2 foot size requirement. 1st graders at Paul Revere Elementary School in Revere, MA Title: Vision of Art and Music

**M&T Used: Transparencies and markers.** They first cut transparency sheets up into 6" sections, created their drawings, and then used clear box tape to tape together their transparencies pieces creating a 2' x 2' submission.

Students at Pauline Central Elementary Art Class in Topeka, Kansas Dream Theme: Art

M&T Used: Tempera, oil pastels, and canvas.

We used art supplies and pictures like pencils, papers, scissors, crayons, and paintbrushes.





St. Mary's Elementary School in St. Mary's, Kansas AND Rossville Grade School in Rossville, Kansas

**M&T** Used: Construction paper, drawing paper, crayons, and laminate. With limited access to other materials and time this group had students fill out questionnaires and laminated four student drawings and forms together into one 2' x 2' panel. With only a 12" laminator available they laminated the individual pieces first and then used clear box tape to assemble them together.

As the students worked they shared the stories behind their art work, it was inspiring to collaborate with artist/musician Daniel Long, photographer Laura Brookhart, the teachers/mentors from Fresh Air Family and all the talented young artists.

St. Andrew's Sewanee School in Sewanee, TN Title - "21 Dreams for the world" Dream Theme - Community

M&T Used: Block printed cotton cloth. Each sixth grader identified a dream for the world and carved a block for printing cloth. The cloth was used for the dream rocket guilt and to create prayer flags.




