At Temple Emunah

Nearly 400,000 out-of-hospital sudden cardiac arrests occur annually, with 88% of all cardiac arrests occurring in the home. **Put very simply: The life you save with CPR is mostly likely to be someone you love.** Sadly, only 32% of cardiac arrest victims get CPR from a bystander and, as a result, less than 8% of people who suffer cardiac arrest outside the hospital survive. If bystander CPR is not provided immediately, a sudden cardiac arrest victim's chance of survival falls 7-10% for every minute of delay. **HOWEVER**, effective bystander CPR provided immediately after sudden cardiac arrest can double or triple a victim's chance of survival. *Be someone who can make a difference!*

Details

- The course lasts 4 hours and you must attend the entire class to become certified.
- The cost of the class is \$50 / person (\$38 for additional members of the same household).
 - Each class can only accommodate 20 people—so sign up today!
 - Teens are welcome to participate.
