

Baby Mittens – Crochet Pattern

Mittens

Round 1: Ch 4, join. Ch 3, 9 DC in loop, join. (10 sts)

Round 2: Ch 3, DC in same st. *DC in next st, 2DC in next st.* Repeat around; DC in last st, join.

Round 3: Ch 3, DC around as in Round 2 (alternating 2 DC & 1 DC). Join. (24 sts)

Round 4: Ch 3; 1 DC in each st around, join. (24 sts)

Rounds 5-10: Repeat Round 4 until mittens reach desired length (mittens in photo have 10 rounds of DC).

Round 11: Ch 1, SC in each stitch around, join. (24 sts)

Finishing: Weave narrow ribbon or baby elastic through 2nd from last row to hold them on baby's wrists. I chained a long string of 100 sts with tiny knots at the end. The photo is of the live size I made the sample. Measure against it.



P.S. ... from Ina ... we are using a 3.5 or 3.75 mm crochet hook ... D, E or F ... check for the mm size ... more of what we are looking for than the letters which seem to be all over the place!
