

NOTES FOR THE PLAIN AND SIMPLE BURP CLOTH

- Our last projects of the season are easy, simple and useful.
- The instructions are straight forward and of course the size can give and take an inch in width and length.
- We are using a size 6 (4.0 mm) or 7 (4.5 mm) knitting needle.
- Let's aim for the finished medium size.
- If you would like to throw a simple knit and purl pattern in there ... go right ahead.

Plain & Simple Burp & Wash Cloths



Disclaimer - I know I'm not the first to come up with this design, especially as a washcloth and that as it's your typical swatch pattern. But I also couldn't find these anywhere on Ravelry when I made them, and I would like the washcloth to have a home.

- * Worked in a standard cotton Sugar'n Cream. One skein gives you one burp cloth or two small wash cloths. Or add a second skein for a larger cloth.

- * These burp cloths are narrower than normal so that they sit right on your shoulder and shouldn't fall off.

- * The small wash cloths are great for children and/or babies.

- * The cotton is oh so soft while in water, and goes through the dryer easily. Actually the more you put these through the washer and dryer the softer they get!

- * When it comes to these, gauge doesn't really matter, but could affect the length. I found I preferred a size 7 needle with the standard Sugar'n Cream, but with the New Twists (multi colored ply), which is a little thinner, I liked a size 6.



Burp Cloth

1-2 skeins Sugar'n Cream

Size 7 needles (straight or circular) needle or crochet hook to hide ends

Gauge: 9 sts x 11 rows = 2 inches (not necessary, but listed for reference) Stitches listed in Small (Medium, Large)

Finished Small: 6.5" x 21.5"

Finished Medium: 7" x 18"

Finished Large: 8.5" x 21.25"

Cast On: 31 (36, 41) stitches

Work 3 rows garter stitch (knit both sides)

Row 5: Knit across

Row 6: Knit 3 sts, purl until 3 sts before end, knit last 3 sts

Repeat Rows 5 & 6 for 90 (100, 110) total rows or desired length Work 3 rows garter stitch

Wash Cloth

1 skein Sugar'n Cream

Size 7 needles (straight or circular)
needle or crochet hook to hide ends

gauge: 9 sts x 11 rows = 2 inches
(not necessary, but listed here for
reference) Stitches listed in Small
(Medium, Large)

Finished Small: 7" x 7"

Finished Medium: 8" x 8"

Finished Large: 9" x 9"

Cast On: 31 (36,41) stitches

Work 3 rows garter stitch (knit both
sides)

Row 5: Knit across

Row 6: Knit 3 sts, purl until 3 sts
before end, knit last 3 sts Repeat

Rows 5 & 6 for 32 (38, 44) total
rows or desired length Work 3 rows
garter stitch

Note - the length of the burp cloths doesn't really matter, the focus is on the width. Make the width comfortable for you and simply knit until you're almost out of yarn, saving enough for the stockinette ends.
