CAMP INFORMATION

REGISTRATION IS EASY!

- Camps should be selected by the grade your child will enter in August 2014.
- Confirmation materials will be provided after completing registration.

TUITION:

Payment is due at the time of registration. The Gulf Coast Exploreum accepts Visa, Mastercard, Discover, and personal checks. Cash will only be accepted in person. All campers are required to purchase one camp shirt for \$10. Additional t-shirts may be purchased at any time for the same price. Families with more than one child attending full day camps within the same week will receive a \$10 discount for each additional child. There are no sibling discounts for half day camps.

TIMES

Full day camps are from 8:00am to 3:30pm. Morning session Pre-K camps will be from 8:00am to 11:30am. The afternoon session from 12:00pm to 3:30pm. Any Pre-K camper who is attending all day will follow full day camp hours. All morning session campers must be picked up by 11:30am and by 3:30pm for afternoon and full day sessions. A fee of \$1.00 a minute is charged per camper after pick up times.

MEAL PLAN

The Gulf Coast Exploreum offers a meal plan for all full day campers. For \$25 your camper will receive a morning snack, lunch with water or Capri Sun, and an afternoon snack. A sample of this menu can be found on page 17 – in the camps guide. There are no sibling discounts for meal plans. Campers who are attending half day camps must supply their own snack and water or juice. Full day campers who choose not to purchase the meal plan must supply am and pm snack as well as a lunch with beverage. The café will not be available for campers outside of the meal plan.

REFUND AND CANCELLATION POLICY:

Refunds will only be issued on cancellation requests made two weeks prior to the start of your camp session. A 20% processing fee is deducted from all refunds. Within two weeks of your camp session, camps may be rescheduled for a \$10.00 fee but no refunds will be processed. Once camp has begun, no refunds or rescheduling will occur. Additionally there are no partial refunds for missed days of class.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Labeling items such as lunch boxes with the camper's name is highly encouraged. The Exploreum is not responsible for any personal items. The Exploreum reserves the right to cancel or reschedule programs for any reason and capacities are subject to change. Individuals requiring special accommodation should submit a written request to the Director of Education thirty days prior to the start of the camp session.



LITTLE EXPLORERS (PM)


Take a trip around the world as a scientist! Visit each continent and explore the animals, plants and climate that make it unique.

I AM BIOLOGY Aug 4-8



MONSTER SCIENCE July 28-August 1




HEALTHY EARTH, HEALTHY YOU July 21-25










IMAX DOME FILM LIBRARY
