

HUBER'S DELI AT PASARBELLA

I am loving the Deli Sandwich (\$7.80, below) at Huber's Deli. The deli is Huber's Butchery's new take-out joint at PasarBella, a new gourmet market at The Grandstand in Bukit Timah.

The sandwich is the butchery's take on the Vietnamese banh mi, a baguette-roll with pate and pickles and other ingredients such as coriander, ham or grilled Vietnamese

Here, the sandwich is filled with the butchery's quality homemade pate, veal lyoner, pork roulade and bacon.

I like that the bun is airy and crusty, and that the pickles of carrot and radish are nice and sour, with just enough kick. The flavours are a mish-mash of East and West, given the pork roulade's Western spice profile, but I think they are fantastic. My only wish is for more coriander (a whole sprig, perhaps). And maybe next time, I might just bring along my own Maggi Sauce, to make it more Vietnamese-like. A little bit of seasoning never hurts.

The deli also offers four varieties of its homemade grilled sausages on buns with toppings such as sauerkraut and caramelised onions.

Grilled sausages in baguettes also cost \$7.80 each.
