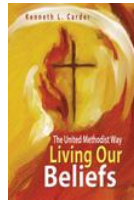

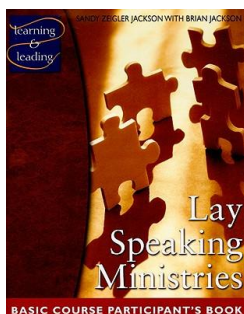


BASIC LAY SERVANT CLASS

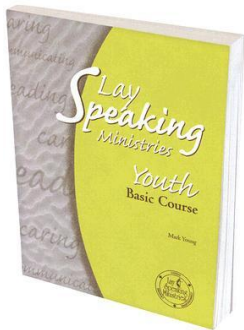
-Participants will be encouraged to recognize and use their spiritual gifts.
