LOS ANGELES: DIRTY MONEY AND DIRTY POLITICS



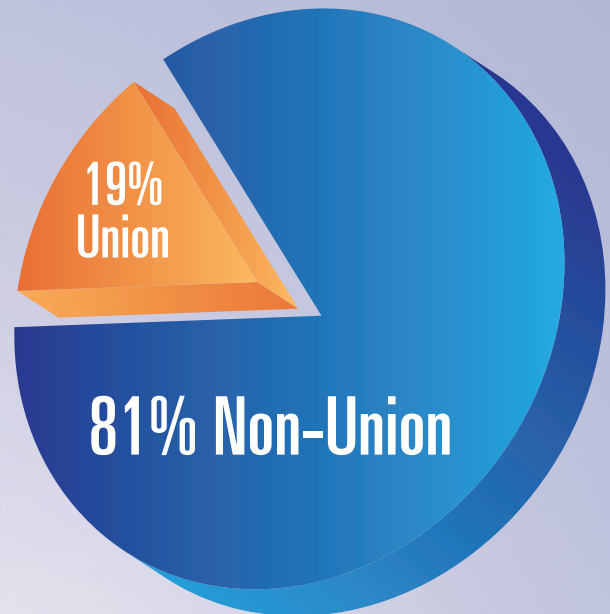
