2014 ANNUAL MAINTENANCE LOCK CLOSURE

The annual maintenance lock closure for Walla Walla District Corps of Engineers is scheduled for March 2014. Maintenance, inspection and repair work will take place at the locks during the closure.

Locks to be closed include McNary Lock & Dam, (CO river mile 292); Ice Harbor Lock & Dam, (SN river mile 9.7); Lower Monumental Lock & Dam, (SN river mile 41.6); Little Goose Lock & Dam, (SN river mile 70.3); and Lower Granite Lock & Dam; (SN river mile 107.3). Please note in the table below McNary and Lower Granite lock will be out of service for two-weeks and the remaining Snake River Projects will be out of service for three-weeks.

McNary and Lower Grainte Locks will close on 1 March and return to service on 15 March 2014. The remaining three Snake River Projects; Ice Harbor, Lower Monumental, Little Goose will close on 1 March and return to service 22 March 2014. The Projects have scheduled routine inspections and maintenance, as well as some non-routine work, such as gate machinery replacement and gudgeon crack welding.
