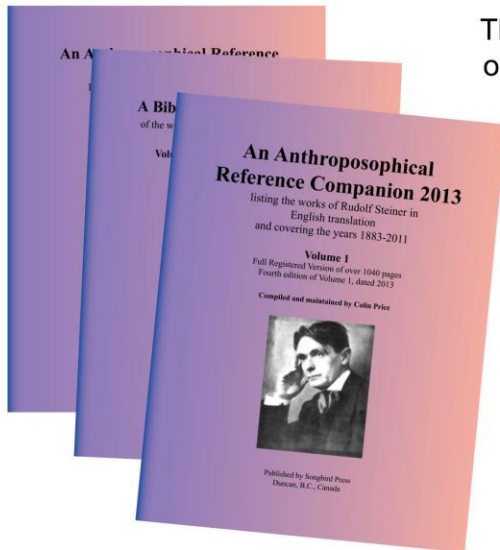

- the publication history of any written work or lecture;
- the different titles of a given lecture to see if you might already have it;
- a search by date, year, subject, format, GA number, word or phrase.

Details of how to do so will be found in the help files that accompany the download. Note that this programme requires you to have the Microsoft Word programme, version 2000, 2003, 2007 or 2010, on your computer, and an operating system of Windows XP, Vista or Windows 7.
