AGRISCIENCE

JTED @ Tanque Verde (Refer to Tanque Verde H.S. schedule for class times)

This program is ideal for future veterinarians, landscape architects, biotechnologists, biologists, horse trainers, zoologists, plant nursery specialists, food distribution managers, food developers, and conservation specialists. Learn the principles of plant science, animal science, nutrition, Ag mechanics, and financial planning.

Eligibility: Grades 9-12 Credits: 1/year (Successful completion of years 1 and 2 satisfy Biology requirement for graduation, successful completion of years 3 and $4 = one \ year \ of \ lab \ science.)$

AUTOMOTIVE TECHNOLOGIES

JTED @ Baboquivari (Refer to Baboquivari H.S. schedule for class times. Note: Campus is located in Sells, AZ)

Our CDX automotive training system makes learning all aspects of automotive repair fun, relevant and thorough. In the Auto Program, you'll evaluate and repair brake systems; diagnose and fix electrical and electronic systems; and work on steering and suspension systems; in addition to general engine performance diagnosis and repair.

Eligibility: Grades 9-12 Credit: 1/year

AVIATION TECHNOLOGY

JTED @ Pima Community College Aviation Center M-TH 4-6 pm

The Aviation Program teaches students to do total aircraft maintenance work, from wheels and brakes to hydraulics, the electrical system, and the engine. Upon graduation, you'll be prepared to take the Federal Aviation Administration certification exams to become an Airframe and Powerplant technician.

Eligibility: Grades 11,12 (12 credits), Pima Community College A#, PCC Assessments

Fees: \$10/semester. Credit issued by JTED: 4 high school, 26 PCC credits/program completion

CERTIFIED NURSING ASSISTANT/CAREGIVER

JTED @ Camino Seco, JTED @ Master Pieces, M-TH 1-3:40 or 4-6:40

Eligibility: Grade 12, GED earners under 21 years Prerequisite: HCF. Fees: \$60, plus supplies. Credit: 3/year

Nursing assistants help patients with their personal needs; bathing, dressing, eating, and monitor vital signs (temperature, pulse, respirations, blood pressure). Students complete 185 hours of instruction, skills lab, and real-world experience working in long-term care facilities.

HCF/CNA/Caregiver 1- year course for GED earners and alt. schedules (must be under age 21) M-F 7:30-11:30 am Fees: \$60, plus supplies. Credit: 3/year

COSMETOLOGY

JTED @ Camino Seco, JTED @ Master Pieces 1-Year Program M-F 7:30-2:30*/2-Year Program M-F 2-4:30 or 5-7:30* *plus summer hours

This 1600-hour program will prepare you to earn your Arizona State Board of Cosmetology license. Students learn both theory and gain hands-on experience to master hair cutting, hair styling, hair color, skin care, makeup, nail technology, infection control, and salon management.

1-Year Program Eligibility: Grade 12, GED earners under 22 years

2-Year Program Eligibility: Grade 11, 12 (seniors responsible for tuition 2nd year) Prerequisites: 10 high school credits with 2 in English by program start, or GED Certificate. Candidates must submit most recent high school transcripts.

Fees: \$210, plus supplies

JTED Credit: 12.5/program completion

CULINARY ARTS

JTED @ Mountain View, JTED @ Santa Rita (See respective high school schedules for class times) Afterschool class T,TH 4-6:30

Students gain experience in a commercial kitchen using state-of-the-art equipment and professional culinary tools. Advanced students gain on-the-job training through our catering services.

Eligibility: Grades 10-12. Credit: 1/year

EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION

JTED @ Mountain View (Refer to Mt. View H.S. schedule for class times) Afterschool class T,TH 4-6:30

Gain the skills needed to be employed in careers that work with and care for infant-to-school age children. Students explore and experience the teaching profession through classroom instruction, structured observation, and hands-on experience in the Little Lions Preschool.

Eligibility: Grades 10-12, Candidates must provide proof of Mantoux TB skin test, Tetanus shot w/Pertussis by program start. Credit: 1/year

FIRE SERVICE

JTED @ Camino Seco M,W 3:30-7:30* JTED @ Master Pieces T,TH 3:30-7:30* (*+ Sat. class dates TBA)

Students participate in classroom activities, physical training, and handson applications with a team of professional firefighters. You will learn Fire Service safety policies and procedures, and earn CPR/First Aid, Hazmat, and Wildlands certification.

Eligibility: Grade 12, candidates must submit a recent school physical by program start. Fees: \$60 plus supplies. Credit: 3/year



GRAPHIC COMMUNICATIONS

JTED @ Flowing Wells (Refer to Flowing Wells H.S. schedule for class times)
Afterschool class T,TH 4-6:30

Sharpen your artistic skills, and learn to use state-of-the-industry software and techniques to design a wide array of work for businesses and clients. Students work in a Mac-equipped lab with Adobe Creative Suite software to produce logos, posters, brochures, and CDs.

Eligibility: Grades 10-12. Credit: 1/year

MINING TECHNOLOGIES

Freeport-McMoRan Mine Training Institute – Sahuarita T, TH 4-6:30

This new introductory program focuses on careers in Industrial Maintenance and Operations, Heavy Equipment Maintenance and Operations, and Industrial Electrician/Lineman. Learn the fundamentals of safety, precision measuring, hydraulics, welding, and earn MSHA certification.

Eligibility: Grades 11-12. Credit: 1/year

HEALTHCARE FOUNDATIONS

JTED @ Camino Seco, JTED @ Master Pieces, M,W 2:15-4:45 or 5-7:30, T, TH 2:15-4:45 or 5-7:30

JTED @ Empire M-F (Refer to Empire H.S. schedule for class times)

This foundational course provides students exposure to a variety of health and medical careers, while providing each student with the tools for success in his/her chosen area. Students will learn about and gain exposure to the following healthcare career areas: Nursing, Medical Assisting, Pharmacy Support Services, and Biomedical Research.

Eligibility: Grades 11,12, GED earners under 21 years Fees: \$30, plus uniform and supplies. Credit: 1/year

MULTIMEDIA TECHNOLOGIES

JTED @ Santa Rita (Refer to Santa Rita H.S. schedule for class times) Afterschool class T,TH 4-6:30

Learn to create interactive and visually stimulating presentations, and gain skills in 3D modeling, animation, and audio mixing to create short films, screenplays, interactive media, and video games.

Eligibility: Grades 10-12. Credit: 1/year

LAW, PUBLIC SAFETY & SECURITY

JTED @ Camino Seco T,TH 3:30-7:30* JTED @ Master Pieces M,W 3:30-7:30* (*+ Sat. class dates TBA)

Students learn criminal justice, public safety, legal systems, search and seizure, law enforcement procedures, and forensics from experienced law enforcement officers.

Eligibility: Grades 11, 12, candidates must submit a recent school physical by program start. Fees: \$60 plus supplies. Credit: 3/year

PRECISION MANUFACTURING

JTED @ Tanque Verde (Refer to Tanque Verde H.S. schedule for class times)

Learn precision engineering and manufacturing with emphases on the design and performance of machine tools, metrology, tooling elements, machine structures, sources of errors, precision machining processes and process planning.

Eligibility: Grades 10-12 Credits: 1/year

MEDICAL ASSISTANT

JTED @ Empire, JTED @ Master Pieces M-TH 2:30-7:30

Master the skills to work in a clinic or physician's office. Learn how to collect blood and other specimens, administer injections, assist with minor surgeries, set up surgical trays, perform screenings for diseases, and to collect patients' medical information such as; weight, blood pressure, and medical history.

Eligibility: Grade 12, GED earners under 21 years Prerequisite: HCF. Fees: \$125 plus supplies. Credit: 4/year

PROJECT SEARCH

University of Arizona Medical Center – South Campus, University of Arizona Main Campus M-F 8-3

Project SEARCH serves students with significant intellectual and developmental disabilities. Typically, these are students who are on an Individual Education Program (IEP) and in their last year of high school eligibility. The most important criterion for acceptance into Project SEARCH is a desire to achieve competitive employment.


