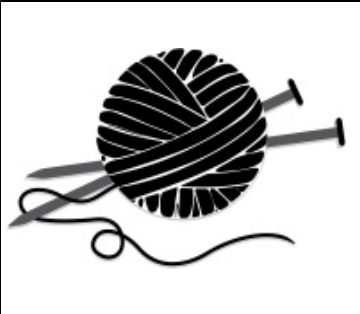

Building Blocks Afghan

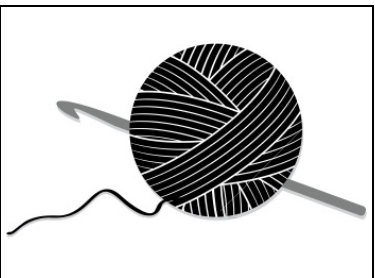

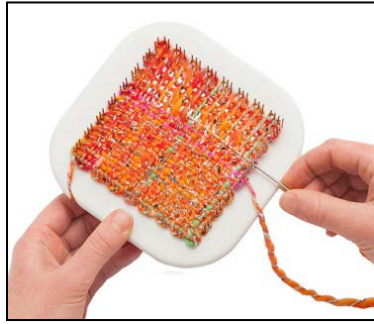
