Its Norwich headquarters and Baking Education Center is located less than a mile from the Inn. The Inn is renowned for its variety of English-style Ales, created at our Brewery & sold only on site. Along with the brewing experience with Jeremy, the weekend offers an **optional** customized bread baking class on Saturday morning. This class will feature bread baking at King Arthur's Baking Education Center with Jasper Murdock Ale grain ingredients. You can take the bread baking class in the morning and enjoy myriad activities in the Upper Valley in the afternoon. Return to the Inn for a brewing orientation, tour and tasting right from the tanks. The weekend will be capped by the "Brewer's Banquet," featuring the creations of our culinary team married with generous samplings of Jasper Murdock Ales beer inspired bread made in the afternoon class.
