The cruise departs Fort Lauderdale, FL on January 24.

It is best to arrive the day prior to cruise embarkation to ensure there are no delays due to weather etc.

If time is tight, the airport is very near the cruise port and offers shuttle service to and from the port.

Use your points to get you to Fort Lauderdale or as soon as flight itineraries are available, my travel agent will be able to secure reservations.

A block of hotels rooms will be secured for your convenience near the port for overnight stays prior or after the cruise.

What to wear?

Weather in the Caribbean can be hot during the daytime, yet could be cool in the evening. You may need a light jacket or sweater for both cool weather and potential rain. The temperature in each cabin is individually controlled for your own comfort.

Shorts, t-shirts, slacks, trousers, casual skirts, blouses and sundresses are all perfect during the day and for our workshops.

For lounging by the pool, pack two bathing suits (an extra suit in case the other is wet) and a pair of casual shoes (e.g., flip-flops, sandals, sneakers). Casual shorts and a couple of t-shirts or a cover-up for getting to and from the pool areas are a must.

Running shoes and workout

wear are necessary if you choose to use the onboard fitness center.

Each evening a schedule of shipboard events will be delivered to your cabin. This newsletter will include the weather forecast as well, as planned activities and the suggested attire each evening for the main dining room. Six of the evenings will be casual: sport shirts and

slacks for men and sundresses or pantsuits for ladies.

Two evenings will be smart casual and two will be formal. Smart casual entails jackets and ties for men and dresses or pantsuits for women. Formal attire is suits and ties or tuxedos for men and cocktail dresses for women.

Don't forget your hat and sunscreen for shore excursions.
