- File size: Your submission should be 100–180dpi and between 5"x7" to 8"x10" in size. The winning image will need to be 300dpi and 8"x10" in size. Make a copy in that file size in case you are selected.
- File format: .jpg
- No text. We are only looking for the bike critter.
- Black and white only; one additional accent color is acceptable. The selected image will be reproduced in both black/white and in color (if any).
- By submitting artwork to the Bike Critter Art Contest for consideration, your submission indicates that you agree to the Terms and Conditions of this contest.

Judging

Designs will be judged on originality, creativity, and appropriateness by a jury of artists and professionals. The winner will be announced on July 25, 2014.

What does the winner get?

The winning drawing will be featured and credited in all of the collateral and promotional material for *Tour da Arts, vol.* 6. This includes fliers, website, product giveaways, and press releases. It's a great addition to your portfolio or a nice way to be recognized for a cool drawing!

- Your submission will be featured in a Tour da Arts, vol. 6 bike critter slideshow.








