Mustangs

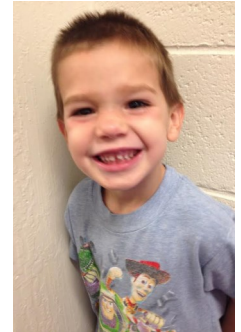
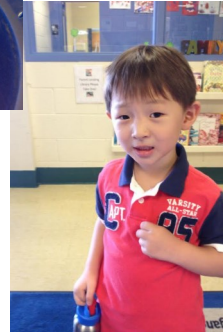

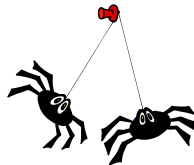
Kindergarten
