Dress, grooming and personal cleanliness are key critical components to your success in securing an interview and at the same time, building professionalism regardless of your occupation. At CareerSource Brevard, our goal is to ensure that we prepare you for employment while maintaining a professional environment at the career centers for all customers. You are encouraged to dress appropriately in order to be referred to an interview the same day if necessary.

CareerSource Brevard career centers have adopted the following dress code for all customers. Listed below are the guidelines:

# **ACCEPTABLE**

- Business casual slacks/long pants
- Clean blue jeans and sneakers (acceptable for Career Center visits but NOT for job interview)
- Business casual or other professional-wear shoes. (Loafers or boots for men and open-toed shoes and dress sandals for women are acceptable)
- Collared shirts, polo shirts, dress shirts, sweaters, blazers and sports coats
- Appropriate length skirts
- Appropriate length blouses or dresses (Discreet sleeveless is acceptable)

# **UNACCEPTABLE**

- Pants that are too low-rise, too tight or too baggy. Jeans with holes and/or dirty. Shorts. Cotton or nylon sweatpants, athletic attire, stretch pants or leggings and stirrups
- Flip Flops, thong sandals or other beach/bedroom slippers
- T-shirts and other shirts with offensive writing or logos
- Short skirts and dresses above mid-thigh
- Tank tops, tube tops, spaghetti strap tops and halter tops. Short shirts or short blouses

All clothing must not have rips, holes or frays
