Kadima's Pre-K program will serve as an introduction to Jewish songs, stories, traditions, and progressive Jewish values.

The Kadima Pre-Kindergarten meets Sundays, twice monthly, 10:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m.

Here is what you can expect from The Kadima Pre-Kindergarten Program:

We recognize that children of this age are already forming their identity based on what they see and hear. We offer both traditional and alternative phrasing of many traditional songs or blessings to reflect unity of the intention and not a bias that may result from a language's grammatical restrictions. We also pay close attention to the pictures in a child's storybook to ensure that gender bias or skin color bias is not presented. Our Pre-K program essentially follows the same anti-bias, holistic, experiential, authentic approach to learning that Kadima provides for all of our learners and the Kadima Community.

Here are some of the activities planned to help your preschooler develop their sense of their Jewish identity while also developing their kindergarten readiness skills:

- Jewish songs to sing and learn, and dances to dance
- Jewish foods to make and recipes to try
- Jewish stories to hear and talk about
- Jewish holidays to explore and experience
- Jewish "vocabulary" to learn
- Hebrew letters and words to learn and practice
- Jewish arts and crafts to make, and gardens to plant
- Jewish concepts to talk about and think about
