The gist:

Registered participants dressed as pirates and wenches spend the day skiing or riding at Cannon Mountain while hunting for pirate treasure! Additionally, registered pirates and wenches will have the opportunity to participate in contests for; most bodacious shoulder parrot, best pirate costume and best wench costume. See below for contest details. There will also be raffles, silent auction, tattoo parlor and a Pirate's Portrait Gallery!

The Treasure Hunt(s):

There will be two Treasure hunts; one map will have participants hunting in the Tuckerbrook Learning Area only and the other treasure map will encompass all of Cannon Mountain. These will be orienteering style treasure hunts, in that participants will be given a map and a punch card. The map will have control points marked on it. Participants will want to find each designated point where they will punch their card. The more control points you find/punches you obtain, the more chances you will have to win the treasure! There will be two treasures... you must declare your intent at time of registration. You may choose either the Scallywags Treasure or the Landlubber & Sprogs Treasure. (Treasure details below)

2012 Event Registration:

Pirates & wenches aged 18 and up!

\$30.00 (early registration prior to 2/1/12) or \$35 (after 1/31/12 or day of) per pirate/wench.

Pirates & wenches aged 17 & under!

\$20.00 (early registration prior to 2/1/12) or \$25 (after 1/31/12 or day of) per pirate/wench.

All entries include:

- **Choice of one Map** – your choice, either hunt for ye treasure all over the great, grand Cannon Mountain or if ye be new to skiin' or ridin' then choose the Tuckerbrook map.

Ballots are included with each registration and you are of course encouraged to purchase additional ballots; at \$1 each, 6 for \$5, or 20 for \$10. Ballots available for purchase at the "Best of" registration table.

Additional Event Day Activities:

Tattoo Parlor – one visit per registered pirate/wench. Your choice of one wet & stick tattoo or hand "painted" custom tattoo; additional tattoos available for \$1.00 each.

Turn Coat Traitors – Check the "Wanted" posters hung in the lodge and help us capture these notorious and traitorous scallywags. Registered participants should be on the lookout for these nefarious evil-doers. An extra punch on your punch card and thus an extra chance to win the treasure for each Turn Coat Traitor "captured".

Pirate Portrait Gallery – Visit the Pirate Portrait Parlor for a souvenir self-photo to commemorate this grand day! Bring the whole crew for a group shot.
