

Situated on a 10-acre “Sanctuary of Trees” in the Somerton section of Northeast Philadelphia, Cranaleith has welcomed and served nearly 35,000 guests since 1998 through its non-denominational program offerings and spirit-rekindling environment of hospitality, respect and trust.



YOU ARE WELCOME HERE...

With three main meeting rooms, our new Education & Conference Center (above left) offers flexible meeting space, state-of-the-art technology and our trademark Cranaleith hospitality, which we've been offering for the past 14 years.

The Conference Hall: With flexibility for groups up to 60 (theater style or at multiple tables), the 29' x 30' space features majestic windows, a vaulted ceiling with mounted projector and a 161" screen. A retractable wall gives access to the adjacent Board Room.

The Board Room: For groups up to 20, this meeting space features a wall-mounted 55" monitor and the flexibility to sit and work around a single table or in smaller groups.

The Living Room: Featuring upholstered chairs & sofas, a fireplace and a wall-mounted 55" monitor, this “homey” space for groups up to 12 is casual, comfortable and private.

Amenities: Cranaleith's Education & Conference Center is universally accessible and provides convenient onsite parking, pedestrian ramps and elevator service. All 3 meeting rooms have Wi-Fi, full audio with wireless mikes, VGA & HDMI wall ports, and touchscreen automation controls for presentations. A break lounge and Gift Shop complete the meeting-room level.

Lower Level: On the Center's spacious lower level, a full-service kitchen provides meals for up to 60 guests in an adjacent Dining Hall with easy access to an outdoor patio and Cranaleith's pond and signature tree-laden grounds.
