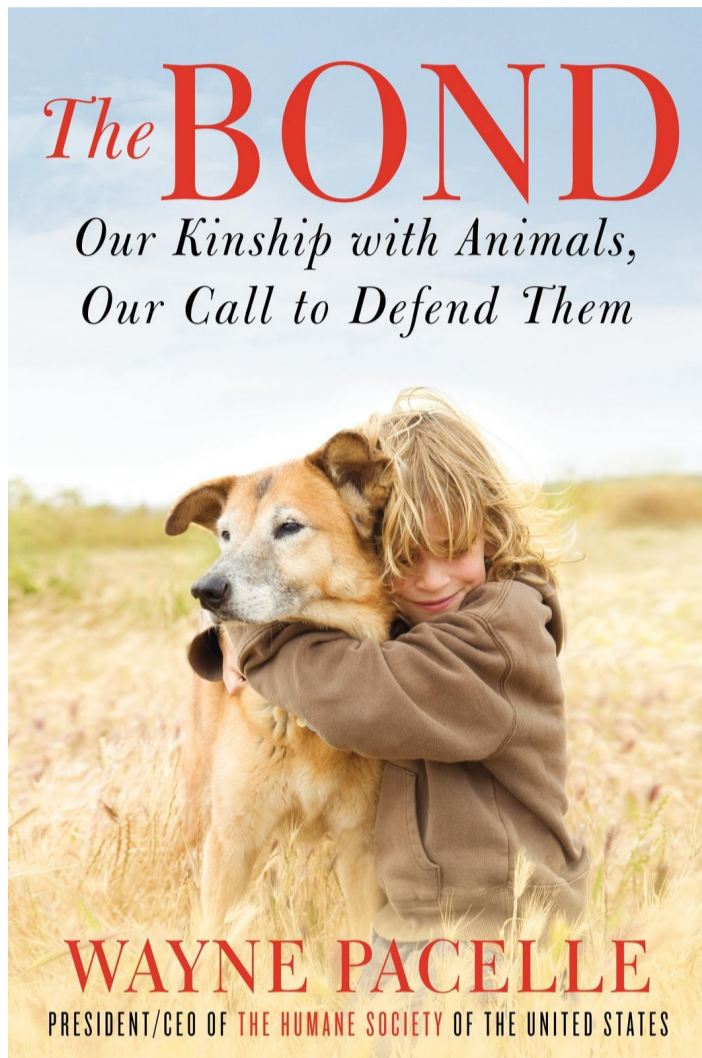


WAYNE PACELLE
