CHECKING THE RIVALRY

The Jackals visit Santander Arena for the fifth of fifteen meetings this season, and the third of eight in Reading. These two East Division foes battled in Elmira on Friday night, with the Jackals bettering the Royals 3-2 in overtime. Allan McPherson scored the game-winner 1:44 into the extra frame to propel the Jackals to victory. Thomas Nesbitt and Colin Jacobs added the other Jackals goals. Elmira's last visit to Reading resulted in a 3-1 win courtesy of two goals from captain Matt Tassone, which sandwiched the game-winner once again scored by Allan McPherson. Goaltender Travis Fullerton has stopped 63 of 66 shots in the last two games against the Royals, earning wins both nights.

ONE-TIMERS

- The Jackals hold a 46-44-11 advantage in the all-time series against the Royals.
- · Sam Marotta leads all rookie netminders with a 2.18 goalsagainst-average. His GAA ranks sixth in the ECHL among all
- · Elmira has vastly improved its power-play unit, which ranked last in the ECHL last season. The Jackals currently rank fifth in the league on the power-play at 21.9% (14-for-64).
- · Steven Shamanski is tied for the ECHL lead among defensemen with 13 points. He leads all rookie blueliners in points. He is tied for the league-lead among defensemen with eight power-play points and is second with six power-play
- · Elmira is sixth in the league allowing 2.81 goals-against-per-
- · Allan McPherson is tied for fourth among rookies with seven goals.

JACKALS IN THE AHL

Seven players who have suited up for the Jackals this season have also appeared in the American Hockey League, Brayden Irwin was leading the ECHL with 14 points when he was recalled by Rochester. Brodie Reid skated in five games for the Jackals then earned a call-up to St. John's and is currently with Adirondack. Justin Kea recorded eight points in 13 games for Elmira before getting reassigned to Rochester by Buffalo. Matt MacKenzie appeared in three games for Elmira and is currently with the Americans. Kevin Sundher played in one pre-season game for the Jackals and has been in Rochester for the full regular season. Sam Marotta and Steven Shamanski earned PTOs with Rochester but are both back in Elmira.

ELMIRA JACKALS HEAD COACH: JAMIE RUSSELL

Russell joins the Jackals following three seasons as an assistant coach at Providence College. While there he coached and developed a stout defensive unit that allowed the seventh-fewest goals in the NCAA last season. The Kamloops, British Columbia native also coached the team's penalty killing unit, which ranked third in the nation in 2014. He contributed to a program-record three consecutive Hockey East semifinal appearances, helped guide the Friars last year to their first NCAA tournament since 2001 and in that same season posted the third highest win total in program history.

Russell brings some head coaching experience with him to the Jackals' bench, as well. He was the bench boss at Michigan Tech University from 2003-2011. During his tenure there he ranked second in program history for career wins, was named the 2007 WCHA Coach of the Year and was a finalist for the 2007 NCAA National Coach of the Year. In the 2006-2007 season, Russell steered the Huskies to the their highest season win total since 1995 and recorded their best conference finish since 1992. He coached one Hobey Baker Award finalist, two All-Americans, five All-WCHA selections, 60 WCHA All-Academic selections and 16 WCHA Scholar athletes.

Russell also has roots in the region dating back to his stint as the lead assistant coach at Cornell University from 1999-2003. He helped mold Cornell into a national powerhouse during his time there. Russell was responsible for the NCAA's top ranked scoring defense and the nation's top ranked penalty kill unit. The Big Red qualified for two NCAA tournaments, advanced to one Frozen Four appearance, won two ECAC regular season championships, the 2003 ECAC Tournament championship and was ranked number one in the nation for the first time in program history. Prior to joining Cornell's staff Russell served as an assistant coach at Ferris State University from 1994-1999.

Russell does bring ECHL experience to Elmira from his playing days. The former defenseman spent two seasons with the Winston-Salem Thunderbirds. He recorded 25 points (6 goals, 19 assists) and 66 penalty minutes in 64 games and captained the Thunderbirds during the 1989-90 campaign. Russell also played four games in the American Hockey League with the Binghamton Whalers during the 1989-90 season. He played his collegiate hockey at Michigan Tech from 1986-89.
