


Virginia's photo ID law goes into effect on July 1, 2014



Valid Virginia driver's license or other photo ID issued by Virginia

When voting, you will need to show one of the following forms of photo identification.




Valid United States passport or other ID issued by the local, state or federal government



Valid employee identification card that has a photograph and that was issued by the employer in the ordinary course of business



Virginia Voter Identification Card



Valid student ID that has a photograph and that was issued by any institution of higher learning in Virginia

*Expired IDs are considered valid

Don't have a photo ID?

You can get a FREE voter identification card from a county registrar in **THREE** steps:

STEP 1: Find a registrar's office

Find a registrar's office that is convenient for you at: <https://www.voterinfo.sbe.virginia.gov/>

STEP 2: Go to the registrar's office to:

- Fill out the *Voter Photo Identification Application*
- Be sure to include the **last four digits** of your **social security number, birthdate, and signature!** Without these, your application will not be processed.
- Get your picture taken
- Give the registrar your electronic signature

STEP 3: Receive your photo voter ID card

You should receive your card in the mail within 7-10 business days.

If you **don't**, call the State Board of Elections at (800) 552-9745.

NOTE: If you are a NEW voter, you will need to register to vote before you can get a voter identification card. The registrar will provide you with an application that you can complete. Your ID card will be mailed to you after your registration is processed.



*If your name or photo no longer matches what is on your current ID, you are eligible to receive a free Voter ID.
