Our Host Family program is the foundation of our team's success both on and off the field. Living with a local family makes their stay in Danbury a home away from home and improves the quality of their experience. ## WHAT DOES IT TAKE TO BE A HOST FAMILY?

- Willingness to welcome a young athlete into your home and provide a private bedroom for the summer. (First week of June generally through the first week of August)
- Your home should be within 25 miles of Danbury, Connecticut.
- Because of the players' extensive schedule, most host families simply keep food available and the players help themselves. You'll be able to sneak in a few family meals if your schedules permit.
- Most players have their own cars for transportation. For those who don't, we pair them up with those who do.

## WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF BEING A HOST FAMILY?

- The players quickly become a part of your family. You'll build relationships that last a lifetime!
- Your immediate family will receive a Host Family pass which gets you into all Danbury Westerner as well as all NECBL games. Your pass comes with a Danbury Westerners lanyard.
- 10% off all Danbury Westerners merchandise at our merchandise stand at Rogers Park. Just show us your Host Family Pass.
- A free week of Danbury Westerners baseball camp for host kids of appropriate ages.
- Batting practice with the Westerners for High School aged host kids.
- To date, over 120 Westerners have been drafted by MLB and 19 have made the Majors. 50 former Westerners were playing professional baseball during the 2013 season.
