Time Warner Email Problems

Have you all of a sudden stopped receiving emails from HBBC? Or, have you noticed an extended lag time in replies to emails that you've sent to a church employee? The reason may be a change in your Road Runner email SPAM settings. The good news is the problem is fixable! Mass email delivery from church or social groups can cause issues from time to time because Internet Service Provider's like Time Warner (Road Runner) are constantly changing their "watchlist," or— who they are blocking from sending email. If you are encountering problems sending or receiving emails to/from HBBC, there are instructions available in the church office to fix this problem, or you can call Time Warner to have them walk you through the process.
