## **The DSM-5 Transition: Training for Mental Health Professionals**

This workshop will provide participants with an opportunity to learn about the changes in DSM-5 that will require new diagnostic approaches to allow for improved accuracy and reliability. The main revisions from the DSM-IV TR to the DSM-5 will be discussed to provide an understanding of the significant changes in the diagnostic framework as well as changes to the organizational structure of the DSM-5. Participants will gain a practical understanding to assist in conceptualizing cases, developing assessments and treatment plans, and reviewing documentation that will be affected by these changes.

Case examples will be used to allow participants to practice new skills and competencies.

### **Topics will include:**

- Substance-related and Addictive Disorder
- Addressing over-diagnosis of Bipolar Disorder in children
- New categories for anxiety and trauma-related disorders
- Changes in Autistic Spectrum Disorder criteria
- Ethical issues involved

Joanna has been a substance abuse counselor and clinical supervisor in rural NC outpatient programs as well as hospital settings. Her experience also includes working at the organizational oversight level and as a college instructor. She has presented at multiple organizational, state, regional, and national conferences and has been a past chair of the Cutting Edge Techniques committee of the IAAOC division of the American Counseling Association.
