

FAQ for Students and Parents



Q: “Who can attend Ivy League & Friends?”

A: Choctaw students who are members of the Scholarship Advisement Program are invited to register. Their parents/guardians and select family members are also invited to attend as student guests.

Guests attending with each student must be registered by the student, at the time the student registers themselves.

Q: “Do parents need to register?”

A: Choctaw students must register for the event through their SAP account. Students can include their parents as their listed guests. Parents may not register separately.

PARENTS: Please make sure the student knows to include you in their registration form!

Q: “Do High school counselors, teachers, administrators, and tribal education officials interested in attending the event need to register?”

A: These guests do not need to register. However, they are encouraged to contact SAP to RSVP.

Q: “When is the event?”

A: November 9th

Q: “What should I wear?” / “Is there a dress code?”

A: There is a business casual dress code. (The “casual” part means that suits are not necessary!)

For girls, business casual dress can include: dress pants, skirts, or

dresses, with dressy tops.

For boys, business casual is: slacks with a polo shirt or dress shirt.

Do not wear: jeans or other denim, sweatshirts or hoodies, t-shirts, or hats.

Q: “What should I bring to Ivy League & Friends?”

A: Please try to bring a portfolio. It really makes a great impression!

A complete portfolio for the event should include: an academic resume (including Native American activities and programs you’ve participated in, and other extracurricular activities), your standardized test scores needed for admission, and copies of your transcript.

Q: “Who is responsible for lodging?” / “Can you book a hotel room for me?” / “Where do I stay while at the event?”

A: Attendees are responsible for their own hotel accommodations—the SAP cannot book a room for you.

Q: Will SAP provide meals?

A: Dinner will be provided on Saturday evening. Lunch will not be provided on Saturday. All attendees will be responsible for their own lunch. There are a number of dining options at the resort.
