

The 13th Annual ICB/TABB Conference will be held May 19-23, 2014 in Cleveland, Ohio. This year's conference will offer numerous classes, workshops and seminars on a variety of current industry topics specifically geared toward working professionals.

ICB through NEMIC will provide certification testing for Supervisors, Technicians, and Contractors who qualify. In today's marketplace, being "certified" is very desirable. The ICB certification documents that ICB Certified Technicians, Supervisors, and Contractors are competent, reliable, and qualified professionals. With the certification, ICB and NEMIC aim to increase your employment and business opportunities.

NEMI CLASSES

TABB Supervisor

The TABB Certified Supervisor directs and oversees work performed by TABB Certified Technicians. The class will discuss the necessary skill sets, required tools and work procedures to meet TABB standards, including the ICB Code of Conduct. This class will instruct supervisors on their responsibilities in overseeing the work performed and reviewing and signing off on the TAB report.

HVAC Fire Life Safety Level 1 Supervisor

The HVAC Fire Life Safety Level 1 Supervisor class focuses on the skills and tools required to direct and oversee the work performed by one or several ICB/TABB Certified HVAC Fire Life Safety Level 1 Technicians. This class will instruct Supervisors on their responsibilities in developing procedures needed to perform an inspection of a building's fire and smoke dampers, as well as explain the responsibilities before, during and after a damper inspection.

HVAC Fire Life Safety Level 2 Supervisor

The HVAC Fire Life Safety Level 2 Supervisor class focuses on the skills and tools required to direct and oversee the work performed by one or several ICB/TABB Certified HVAC Fire Life Safety Level 2 Technicians. This class outlines the National Fire Protection Association standards on which most local and state fire and life safety codes are based, and trains supervisors on how to inspect, test, and maintain smoke control and smoke management systems in a building.

Sound & Vibration Supervisor

Ideally, HVAC systems should run smoothly and with minimal noise. However, some "kick in" with vibrations and loud noises can occur. The sound and vibration professional is vital in creating a solution using techniques of measurement and analysis. This class will cover the necessary skills and responsibilities of the TABB Sound and Vibration Supervisor.

ITI CLASSES

Total Building Energy Audit Technician

Participants will be familiarized with standardized protocols that are applied consistently to assess the performance of a commercial/institutional building. The protocols identify what to measure, how to measure and how often it is to be measured. The attendees will be acquainted with the basic and intermediate levels of compliance. Procedures on how to gather data to determine the total annual energy cost will be presented in detail.

Fume Hood Performance Testing Technician

The ITI will be offering a training class to review prescribed testing procedures on chemical fume hoods per ANSI/ASHRAE Standard 110 methodology. The two day program will introduce and use the ITI's new training curriculum on fume hood performance testing following our new Student Guide for members and Instructors Guide for JATC Instructors who attend. Fume hood performance testing requires extensive knowledge of testing, adjusting, and balancing procedures; thus a current TABB Technician or TABB Supervisor certification is a prerequisite.
