

# CSI CLSB/SKT Tour

In preparation for your tour of the Collaborative Life Sciences and Skourtes Tower Project we ask you to review the following items:



## Tour Notes

The project is an active worksite and construction work will be ongoing during your tour. Please note the following:

1. Proper clothing is required, which includes:
  - ✓ Full length pants.
  - ✓ Closed toed leather shoes. No tennis shoes. You will be walking over rough and rocky exterior areas to get to the building. Please make sure you have heavy soled shoes that you can get dusty.
  - ✓ Shirt with sleeves. No sleeveless shirts or tank tops.
  - ✓ You will be provided a hard hat, safety glass and a safety vest to wear on your tour.
2. There will be six (6) tour stations with a total tour time of approximately ninety minutes (90). You will be assigned to a tour group and need to stay with that group at all times as it makes the tour rotation.
3. Tour groups will be asked to walk up and down a few flights of stairs, typically only up one floor at a time with rest periods in between.
4. There is the potential for loud noises during the tour. If you are sensitive to loud noises you will want to bring hearing protection.
5. Safety is our #1 priority. Please make sure you are dressed appropriately and stay with your group.



## Time & Location

Please park in the Schnitzer parking lot and follow the signs to the JE Dunn construction trailer. You may assemble in the construction trailer at 4:30 pm. Groups will be sent out on a first come basis.

**The last tour group will leave the construction trailer at 4:40 pm.** If you wish to tour with a friend or co-worker please make sure to walk over together so that you can make it out in the same group. Once you start the tour you will be asked to finish the entire tour with the group. All hard hats, safety vests and safety glasses will be provided. Please complete the site access release before attending the tour. Release forms are available at the jobsite. All tours participants are required to sign the release.

IN CONSIDERATION of being permitted access to the Project construction site on which Project JE Dunn Construction Company is the General Contractor, RELEASOR, for herself/himself, her/his legal representatives, heirs and assigns, hereby releases and forever discharges JE Dunn Construction Company and the Owner of the above named Project, their officers, directors, employees and subcontractors, and each of them, herein referred to the RELEASES, of and from any and every claim, demand, action or right of action, of whatever kind of nature, either in law or equity, arising from or by reason of any bodily injury, death or property damage resulting or arising from RELEASOR'S access to the site of the above named Project, even if caused by the negligent act or omission of RELEASEES.

Please note that exposure to potential chemical hazards in soil are Polycyclic Aromatic Hydrocarbon (PAH), Polychlorinated Biphenyls (PCBs); Lead; Creosote; and potentially Asbestos (present on adjacent properties) and/or Hydrogen Sulfide identified in low trace amounts is at your own risk.

RELEASOR, agrees to coordinate access to the site with RELEASEE'S project manager and superintendent on site. Further, RELEASOR agrees that RELEASOR will be accompanied on the site by RELEASEE, or their representatives.

This RELEASE contains the entire Agreement between the Parties hereto and the terms of this RELEASE are contractual and not a mere recital.

RELEASOR has carefully read the foregoing RELEASE and knows the contents thereof and signs this RELEASE as her/his own free act.
