Session Descriptions

Child Abuse and Neglect & Shaken Baby Syndrome: You want to help protect innocent children from abuse and in this session you will learn how. You will also learn what the law requires of you, to protect yourself. This session teaches you to weave a web of protective support around children and families, making them stronger. You will learn to identify various forms of abuse, including shaken baby syndrome. Learn how to tell the difference between an accident and abuse, and what to do when you suspect abuse or neglect. *Kansas and Missouri Core Competencies for Early Care and Education Professionals* Content Area V: Health, Safety, and Nutrition/Knowledge of Regulations Level 1 & 2, Content Area VI: Interactions with Children/Providing Individual Guidance Level 1, Contact Area VII: Program Planning and Development Level 1

What Infants and Toddlers are Telling Us: What have the infants or toddlers you work with told you today? Did you know that infants "talk" through crying and other non-verbal communications? While infants and toddlers cannot speak with words, they do communicate in many other ways. Learn how these cues form the foundation of language development. Learn how temperament, challenging behaviors and cultural traditions can shape how an infant or toddler will communicate. This session will also share how to discover the communication and meaning of behaviors such as biting and tantrums. *Kansas and Missouri Core Competencies for Early Care and Education Professionals* Content Area I: Child and Youth Growth and Development/Promoting Growth and Development Level 2c, & Content Area II: Learning Environment and Curriculum/Promoting Language and Communication Development Level 2a

Guiding Children's Behavior: Ever wonder why children misbehave? Discover the causes of and techniques to reduce the behavior problems in your classroom or family child care. Learn how to make group management an interactive process, rather than a chore, by promoting social and emotional development, while building responsibility in young children. We will help you learn to introduce children to choices that you and they can live with. For ALL Trainings:

- All sessions count towards Department of Health and Senior Services annual training requirements. Certificates will be handed out before you leave. The Departments of Social Services and Health and Senior Services require that participants attend the entire training in order to receive a certificate. Q&A's about Online Professional Development Events

What can I expect with the "real-time" online professional development event?

We are excited to offer "real-time" online professional development events. These events will make a great addition to our face-to-face professional development events. When you participate in a training event utilizing our "real-time" online services, you can expect to get the same high quality training you count on with our face-to-face events. Your facilitator will present the information through the computer and phone line. You will receive your participant workbook via email once you register for the event. Based on the professional event you register for, you may be directed to complete some prep work for the event.

What type of equipment do I need to participate in the "real-time" Professional Development Event?

In order to participate fully in the online professional development event, you will need the following to access the information:

- Phone line (you will call in to a toll free number and be on the phone for the whole workshop)
- Computer with internet access (up to three people can use one computer for the training)
- Access to a printer to print your workbook materials

What skills are required to participate in "real-time" on-line professional development events?

Basic computer skills are essential in order to maximize learning. Participants who know how to minimize their screen, access the internet, and navigate to different websites will maximize their learning from our "real-time" online professional development events.

How will I receive my materials?

Once you register, you will receive an email from the instructor (check your spam or junk mail) with the materials you will need for the professional development event. If you do not receive your materials 24 hours prior to the training, please call us at 800-243-9685.

Is there any prep work to do prior to the professional development event?

Some of our professional development events do require preparation prior to the event. This may include reading an article, watching short video clips on the internet, or completing a questionnaire.

How do I receive my training certificate?

Once you complete the training and activities, we will mail your certificate to the address you provided on your registration form. Our trainings are very interactive. We expect participation during the "real-time" online events through discussion and completion of activities. Please note, in order to receive your certificate you are required to participate in the discussions and activities.
