#### **About Paulina**

Paulina Cooper was born April 17, 1998. She was outgoing, fearless, giving, and had an amazing ability to connect. She was diagnosed with an intrinsic pontine glioma in August of 2003 at the age of 5. Through 15 months of radiation and chemotherapy and clinical trials she remained brave, peaceful, comforting and wise. She left this world on September 21, 2004. She is our hero. Her ability to connect, I believe was her life's purpose. To make us realize that we must be in relationship with one another, with family, friends, neighbors, strangers and all walks of life. This is why we named this race the Dot-to-Dot race. By connecting the dots, we stay in union with each other and with God, and continue Paulina's legacy, of spreading her message of love, union and relationship.

Facts about brain tumors

- Everyday 9 children are diagnosed
- Leading cause of cancer death
- 120 different types of pediatric tumors
- Poorer survival rates than breast cancer patient

Only 2 new treatments for brain tumors have been approved in the past 25 years. More has been learned about brain tumor in the last 10 years than in the previous 100 years. Yet, mortality rates remain unchanged during the last 10 years.

The Rory David Deutsch Foundation is a non-profit foundation dedicated to the eradication of pediatric brain tumors. All money raised will go into researching and developing effective treatments for children with aggressive brain tumors.

#### What to expect at packet pick up:

- You do not need to bring anything, but it is helpful to have a copy of your confirmation email on your phone or printed
- You are welcome to pick up packets for friends and family members
- In your packet, you will find your bib, twist ties, and timing chip to attach to your shoe



#### About race day:

- Before the race, pin your bib to the front of your shirt and attach your timing chip to your <u>shoe</u> with twist ties (pictured to the side).
  Your time will not be captured if the chip is anywhere other than your shoe.
- Your official start time will be captured by the timing chip when you cross the starting mat; finish time, when you cross the finish mat.
- The timing chips are reusable, and once you cross the finish line, someone will clip the chip off your shoe.



- If you are unable to run or do not wish to be timed, please return your timing chip either at packet pick up, the race, or mail it to the address below.




#### Results and Awards
