Assistant/Associate Professor - Responsibilities include clinical and teaching duties associated with a family medicine residency program. Qualified applicants must possess an MD or DO degree, must have graduated from an accredited residency training program and be Board Certified/Board Eligible in Family Medicine or Osteopathic Medicine. Preference will be given to applicants who want to practice full scope family medicine with an emphasis on hospital inpatient service. The practice of Obstetrics is desirable but not required.
