Opening Keynote Speaker, Thursday, March 20, 2014

Jeffrey Barth, Ph.D., ABPP-CN holds the position of Professor and Co-Director of the Neurocognitive Assessment Laboratory and Section Head, Neurocognitive Studies in the Department of Psychiatry and Neurobehavioral Sciences, with joint appointments in the Department of Neurological Surgery and the Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering at the UVa Medical and Engineering Schools. He is also one of the founders of the UVa Brain Injury and Sports Concussion Institute, and he is the PI and Senior Scientist for Defense and Veterans Brain Injury Center: Charlottesville. Dr. Barth is a member of the NFL Players Association Concussion Committee and works with the Department of Defense and the American Academy of Neurology on the development of concussion management guidelines.

Morning Keynote Speaker, Friday, March 21, 2014



Joanne Finegan, MSA, CTRS - Earning her degree in 1983 from Pennsylvania State University was an early stepping stone for Joanne Finegan, ReMed Recovery Care Center's CEO and Managing Partner. Finegan leads ReMed, a rehabilitation and supported living provider for people with acquired brain injury, utilizing her skills as a Certified Therapeutic Recreation Specialist, her Masters Degree in Administration (West Chester University, 1990) and her years of experience specializing in brain injury treatment. She has worked continuously on educating others on the impact and lifelong effects of brain injury and utilizes ReMed's "real life rehabilitation" model as her foundation. She leads ReMed by applying practical management, communication and

leadership skills in today's fast-paced health care environment. Finegan is a well-known presenter and publisher on key issues related to brain injury, such as funding and resources, long-term supports, adjustment, socialization, sexuality, recreation and leisure.

Rosemary Rawlins is the blogger of "Learning by Accident: A Blog About Caregiving and TBI" for BrainLine.org, an award winning WETA multimedia site. She is also the author of a book by the same name, "Learning by Accident," a caregiver's story about the intense two-year period following her husband's severe traumatic brain injury — the result of being struck by a car when riding his bicycle. Rosemary has eight years experience in full-time caregiving for loved ones with brain injury, dementia, and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease. HealthSouth Rehabilitation Hospital of Virginia presented Rosemary and her

family with the "2011 No Barriers Award" in September 2011. She and her husband Hugh were featured in the 2013 Bronze Telly Award-winning video about Relationships after TBI. Rosemary and Hugh were also featured on the front page of the New York Times Science Section in January 2012.

Conference Terms & Conditions of Agreement

1) Exhibit Staffing

Marketing or other personnel who staff sponsor booths must complete a registration form. Each sponsor can determine whether exhibit staff members will be covered by the registration(s) included as part of sponsorship benefits, or whether they'll be covered instead by fees paid for additional registrations. All participants sent by a sponsor <u>must</u> be registered and their costs covered.

2) Assignment of Space and Payment

Booths will be assigned by BIAM upon receipt of signed Conference Registration Form and payment. All space will be assigned based on date of receipt and level of sponsorship. Full payment is required with the signed agreement to qualify for booth assignment.

3) Film, Sound Devices, and Lighting

Sound movies, slide shows, or other sound devices should be turned to conversational level and must not be objectionable to neighboring Exhibitors. Any equipment that emits excessive noise must be run intermittently for specific demonstrations only. BIAM reserves the right to restrict the use of glaring lights of objectionable lighting effects.

4) Exhibitor Space

Sponsors at the Diamond, Platinum, and Gold levels will be provided with two 6' tables and chairs. Sponsors at the Silver, Bronze, and Emerald levels will be provided with 6' tables and chairs. If the exhibit includes a pop-up or large floor (not tabletop) display, a table will not be provided. If an Exhibitor would like and/or needs additional space, this can be negotiated with BIAM staff in advance of the conference. Exhibitors shall in no way infringe upon or take over another Exhibitor's space, public areas, or walk-ways, whether that space is occupied or not.

5) Subletting of Space

Only one firm may exhibit in a single space. Furthermore, products from different firms cannot be sold in a single space.

6) Standard Booth Equipment

Standard Booth Equipment will consist of a draped 6' x 36" table and chairs. An additional fee of \$25 will be assessed for Silver, Bronze, or Emerald Level sponsors who require Oversized Booth Equipment.

7) Fire Safety and Health

The Exhibitor assumes all responsibility for compliance with local, city and state ordinances and Terms and Conditions covering fire, safety and health. Exhibitor provides the necessary shielding or safety items to protect other from equipment that is operable or any other materials, processes or operations which might cause bodily harm. All parts of all displays must meet the specifications of local fire authorities.

8) Liabilities

Exhibitor agrees that BIAM shall not be liable for any damage or liability of any kind or for any damage or injury to persons during the term of this agreement, from any cause whatsoever by reason of use, occupation and enjoyment of exhibit space by Exhibitor, or any person thereon with the consent of Exhibitor, and the Exhibi-

tor will indemnify and hold harmless BIAM from all liability whatsoever, caused by negligence or breach of obligation by Exhibitor or its employees or representatives.

9) Inability to Perform

If BIAM should be prevented from holding the exhibit program by any cause beyond its control (such as fire, strikes, Acts of God, etc.) or if it cannot permit the Exhibitor to occupy his space due to circumstances beyond its control, BIAM will refund to the Exhibitor the amount of the rental paid by the Exhibitor, less a proportionate share of the conference expenses, and BIAM shall have no further obligation or liability to the Exhibitor.

10) Cancellation

Cancellations received in writing on corporate letterhead by the BIAM office by February 25, 2014, will receive a full refund, less a \$75 processing fee. Cancellations are not accepted after February 25, 2014. Such a cancellation shall be considered a default on the part of the Exhibitor, and any monies paid hereunder shall be retained by BIAM as liquidated damages.
