Amend Article IX, Section 4, by striking subsection d and substituting: "d. be designated as Vice President for Leadership Development, Vice President for Regions and Councils, Vice President for Membership Development, and Vice President for Educational Development"

# **ARTICLE IX: DUTIES OF OFFICERS**

Section 4. The four vice presidents shall:

#### **Proposed amendment 2:**

Amend Article VIII by striking Section 7 and substituting:

"Section 7. In case of a vacancy in the office of president, the president elect shall become president and shall hold office for the balance of the term. In filling the vacancy the president elect shall be entitled to continue in the presidency for the following term providing not more than one half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the full term as president has been served. A vacancy in the office of president elect shall be filled at the next convention by the voting body. In the interim, duties of the president elect shall be delegated by the president. A vacancy in any office other than president or president-elect shall be filled by the board of directors. In filling vacancies the vote shall be taken by ballot. If more than one candidate for an office is presented, the election may be by mail ballot."

If the office of the president-elect becomes vacant, the office shall remain vacant until the next convention. At that time, an election will be held for the unexpired portion of the term. During the interim period, the duties of the president elect shall be delegated by the president. A vacancy in any office other than president or president-elect shall be filled by the board of directors. In filling vacancies the vote shall be taken by ballot. If more than one candidate for an office is presented, the election may be by mail ballot.

Rationale: The president elect has the training and experience necessary to take office.

- c. ensure the accounts audited annually by a certified public accountant approved by the executive committee;
- d. perform such other duties as may be provided for by these bylaws, prescribed by the parliamentary authority, or directed by the president, the board of directors or the executive committee.

- f. Countersign checks in emergencies
- g. Inspect the monthly financial statements, and
- h. Serve as chair of the Budget and Restricted Funds committee"

- e. shall get the signature of the president or vice president for leadership upon orders for disbursement;
- f. disburse the funds of the Florida PTA only in accordance with the budget approved by the board of directors or pursuant to an appropriation especially made by the board;
- a. render a written statement of accounts at all meetings of the board of directors and of the executive committee and at other times when requested to do so by the president;
- b. present an annual, audited report of the financial condition of the organization at the annual convention;
- i. shall remit, or cause to be remitted, as required by National PTA to the national treasurer all money due the National PTA accompanied by a statement giving the name and location of each local unit from which these dues were received and the number of members in each local unit;
- c. <u>have ensure</u> the accounts audited annually by a certified public accountant approved by the executive committee;
- d. perform such other duties as may be provided for by these bylaws, prescribed by the parliamentary authority, or directed by the president, the board of directors or the executive committee.
