It is our goal to ensure that Project Re-Direct remains available to help guide our youth away from a life of being uneducated, unemployed or incarcerated or simply put unproductive.

Project Re-Direct is an alternative sentencing program operated by the Gang Bureau of the Brooklyn District Attorney's Office. The program offers non-jail dispositions to male defendants between the ages of 14-22. The purpose of the program is to give young males the opportunity to leave the gang and violent lifestyle to become productive members of society. Project Re-Direct also provides a variety of other services, including but not limited to **Mentorship Partners**, **One-on-One Counseling**, **Anger Management Counseling**, **GPS monitoring** along with **Job Readiness** & **Placement Resources**. Each participant is partnered with a mentor to address particular needs. They are required to perform community service and complete their education through High school, GED Program, College or Vocational training. The benefits of Project Re-Direct are too numerous to mention but it was developed to help young men, who were going down the wrong path, realize their potential and transform their life for the better and decrease the flow of the School-to-Prison Pipeline.
