

Friends of Northern Lake Champlain Century Race

25 Mile Loop

Saturday - 22 June 2013 - 8:00AM

Riding 25 miles to highlight the beauties of Northern Lake Champlain and the opportunities to improve water quality.

The 25 mile ride starts north on US-2 and progresses along the east shore and Grand Isle, briefly back on US-2, then to the west shore and around the southern end of South Hero back to the Sandbar. Beautiful lake views!

- *0.0 Sandbar State Park... START west over the bridge
CONTINUE north on US-2
6.7 Turn RIGHT onto Town Line Rd
7.6 Bear LEFT around onto East Shore Rd
10.0 RIGHT onto US-2
10.8 LEFT onto Hyde Rd
*10.9 Break at Grand Isle Library
CONTINUE west on Hyde Rd
12.2 LEFT onto Adams School Rd
12.5 RIGHT onto Quaker Rd
13.3 LEFT onto West Shore Rd
14.2 RIGHT onto VT-314
15.9 Bear RIGHT to continue on West Shore Rd where VT-314 turns inland (West Shore Rd is unpaved for approx 5.6 miles but a good ride.)
+ (see alternate route below to stay on paved roads.)
PASS by Sunset, Station and Lakeview Roads
21.5 LEFT onto South St
22.5 RIGHT onto Landon Rd
23.9 RIGHT onto US-2
*25.9 END at Sandbar State Park - You've done a 1/4 Century!
- + Alternate Route to avoid unpaved road along the lake:
15.9 Bear LEFT to continue on VT-314 where West Shore Rd turns off
17.4 RIGHT back onto US-2
19.4 RIGHT onto South St toward the Folsom School (sign)
20.6 LEFT onto Landon Rd - PASS by East Shore Rd
22.2 RIGHT back onto US-2
*24.3 END at Sandbar State Park - You've done a 1/4 Century!
- *Provides a rest stop and bathroom.
Some of these stops provide food.

Ride safely and have a great time!
