**CONTRIBUTIONS UPDATE**

Offerings for the first six weeks of our new fiscal year have averaged about \$26,300 compared to our budget need of \$28,750 for 2013-14. Please keep praying to the Lord to move His people to provide for His work.



**“LESS IS MORE” CAMPAIGN UPDATE:**

We are down to the last two months of our three-year Less Is More campaign (Nov 2010-Nov 2013). Gifts now total \$1,225,000! We have now paid \$966,000 toward our original goal of retiring \$1,000,000 of debt, plus doing \$200,000 of campus completion projects and missions. Along with all our other debt reduction, our total debt is down from \$3.2 million to about \$1.35 million. That reduction in debt has freed up about \$180,000/yr for ongoing ministry in the 2013-14 fiscal year. Those dollars are shared 2/3... 1/3 between church and school budgets, and are used to underwrite ministry staff as well as other operational expenses. **LESS DEBT DOES MEAN MORE MINISTRY!** Thanks to all for continuing to use those LESS IS MORE offering envelopes ... in the pew racks, and at the Connections Centers.
