Not all of our clients have disabilities like Ivan, pictured at left, who works in our Job Training Program. But all do have needs of some kind. For instance, this year we helped 22 students with disabilities at Floyd County High School successfully transition from school into adult life in the community. Their disabilities can be developmental, intellectual or learning; or others like autism, epilepsy, chronic mental illness, or physical impairments.



Students with disabilities often do not receive the same opportunities as those without disabilities, so their transition into society, college, or the workforce can be difficult. Our program helped these special-needs students learn to set goals such as pursuing further education, housing, and employment, which increased their confidence. The program was funded through a generous grant from the Horseshoe Foundation of Floyd County.

New Hope serves thousands of families across 13 Southern Indiana counties, meeting critical needs for children of all ages, families in crisis, adults with physical or developmental disabilities, and seniors in need of special housing or in-home care.
