The Spring Clinics offer an easy way to stay in field hockey shape and improve on skills. Each session will include 60 minutes of skill development and 30 minutes of scrimmage/games. The sessions will run 6 Saturdays from April – May.

Summer league will focus mostly on game experience and play, with the occasional warm-up drill. Teams will be formed based on experience level. The league will run Tuesdays and Thursdays from June – July.

Freshman camp is designed for players who have not competed in high school. As a beginner camp, it will focus on mastering the fundamentals while having fun learning a new sport. Sticks are available for borrow if needed, but players should have shinguards and mouthguard.

Intermediate camp is designed to prepare players for the high school season. It will involve more advanced skill mastery such as hits and sweeps, advanced passing and shooting tactics, and conditioning.

The Colorado State Games is a fun but intensive 5 game weekend tournament. At least 2 camps or 1 season playing experience is needed to compete.
