His OHL career culminated in a J. Ross Robertson championship season, after leading the Petes past the highly talented London Knights in 4 straight games



Jamie has spent most of his professional hockey career in the American Hockey League, playing for: Manitoba; lowa; Grand Rapids and Providence. He has also competed in the 2013 AHL All Star game representing the hometown Providence Bruins.
